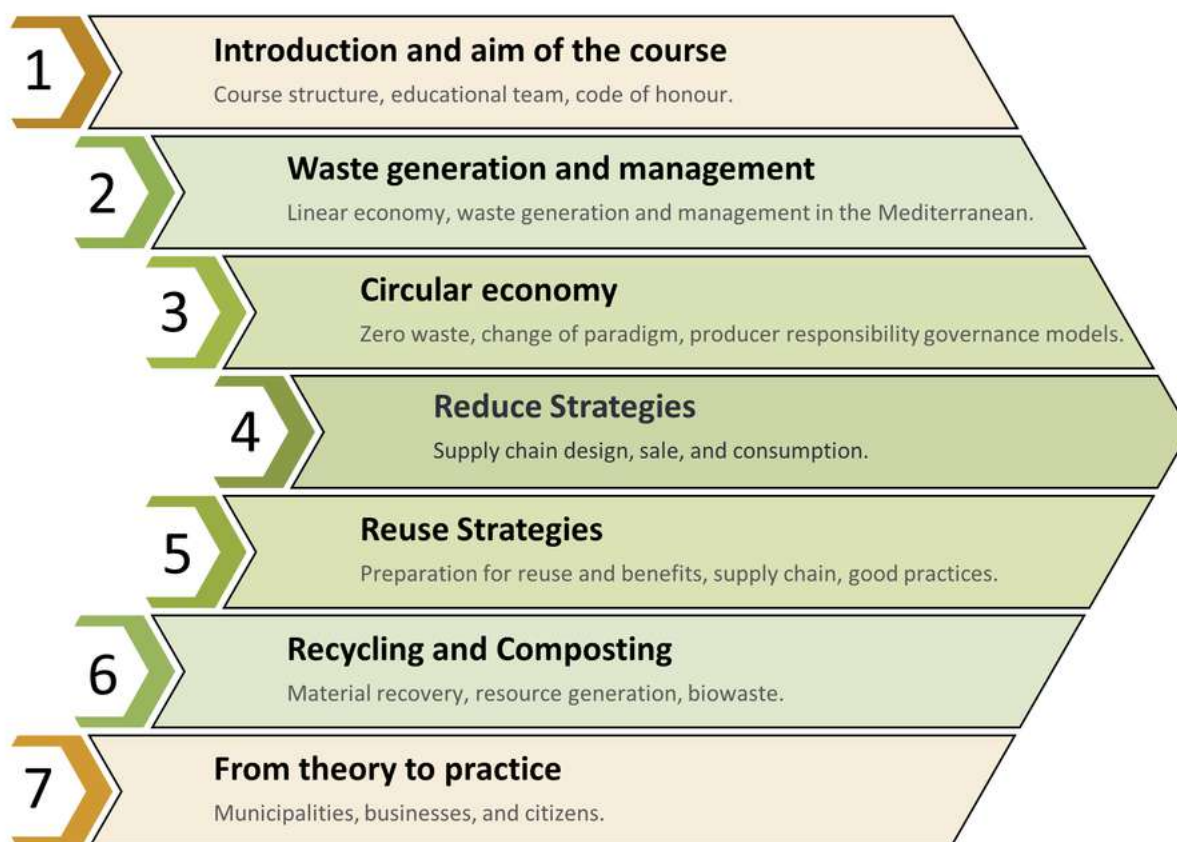
02 **Platform**

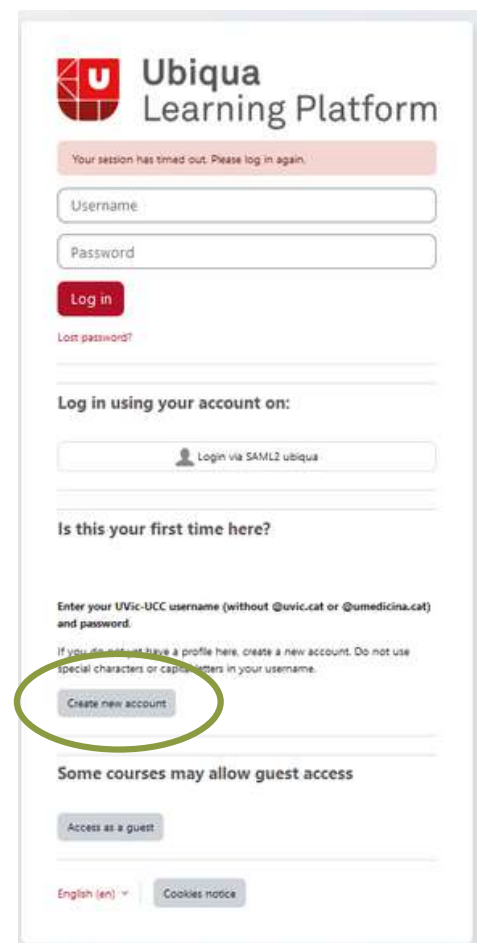
